



## DDA Meter information

### **What do the colors mean on the meters.**

- Red-Means you need to add time to the meter/ Pay the meter
- Green-Means you can park, and your space is paid for
- Yellow-Means you are about to run out of time
- Blue- It is a handicap space
- After 5 pm all the colors change

### **Prohibited spaces**

Red curbs and yellow curbs are prohibited spaces. You cannot park there at any time of the day the system will give you an automatic ticket. This rule includes weekdays after 5 PM and weekends. These spaces are monitored 24/7.

### **Handicap spaces**

Spaces #175-177 are senior express bill pay spaces, they are free for 30 minutes. They are in front of the city hall.

Handicap parking is NOT free unless you have a yellow free parking endorsement on your placard

### **Free spaces**

5th and 7th Street spaces are free parking
